

NYS DPS DMM System: Cases and Filings

Overview

The New York State Department of Public Service (NYS DPS) Document and Matter Management (DMM) system is the central repository for regulatory cases, matters, and associated filings for public utilities and related proceedings in New York State. It is used to document, manage, and provide public access to case records and filings for regulatory matters overseen by the Public Service Commission.

Number of Documented Cases

The DMM system contains thousands of cases, each assigned a unique matter or case number. However, the exact, up-to-date total number of documented cases is not directly published in a summary statistic on the public-facing DMM portal. Users can search for cases by number, company, matter type, or other criteria, but a cumulative count is not displayed on the main search page or in annual summary reports. To determine the precise number of cases, one would need to perform an advanced search with broad criteria to capture all entries, which the system is designed to facilitate for public transparency^{[1] [2]}.

Number of Filings Posted

Similarly, the DMM system hosts a vast number of filings—these include petitions, briefs, orders, public comments, and supporting documentation for each case. Each case can have dozens or even hundreds of individual filings posted over its lifecycle. The total number of filings is not published as a single statistic on the DMM portal or in annual reports, but the system is structured to allow users to search and filter filings by date, case, document type, or organization. All filings, unless confidential, are posted and accessible through the DMM interface^{[1] [3]}.

How to Access Case and Filing Totals

- **Case Search:** Users can use the "Case/Matter Search" function on the DMM portal to view all active and closed cases. The search results will display the number of cases matching the search criteria^[1].
- **Filing Search:** The "Document Search" function allows users to filter filings by date range, document type, or case number. The result set will show the number of filings matching the criteria^{[1] [3]}.

Additional Notes

- The DMM system is updated continuously as new cases are opened and filings are submitted.
- For a precise current count, users are encouraged to use the advanced search features on the DMM website, as the numbers fluctuate with ongoing regulatory activity^[1] ^[2] ^[3].
